



B1: Priority road

B5: Give way (Yield)



B6: Mandatory stop



B7: Cyclists crossing - Give way for cyclists

Right-of-way and yield signs indicate the obligation to yield.



At a cyclist's crossing, a motorist must give way to a bicycle approaching from the right or left. At a regular pedestrian crossing, a cyclist must give way to a car when crossing the roadway.



A mandatory stopping sign requires you to stop, even if there is no visible traffic on the road to avoid. Each driver must stop in turn at the correct stopping point.
